You will be supplied with a Plinth 750 mm height with a base area 225 x 225 for your pedestal design to sit on top of. Your design must be able to be moved from the stage to the display area. (assistance will be available.)

You will need to provide all your own sundries, accessories, fresh flower & horticultural materials for this design, 70% horticultural material & 30% sundries & accessories. The design is to be no taller than 1.4 metres and no wider than 1.2 metres.

You will also need to provide a little writing (A4) behind your design, which will be displayed with your pedestal.

Your pedestal will be displayed in our Floral area for the public to view. What great exposure to advertise your business.
